- Continually improve the company's environmental performance by setting annual targets and reviewing our objectives (annually) and measure the progress.
- Carry out an annual review and update of this policy and other environmental control systems employed by the company.

Employees are asked to co-operate in the operation of this policy and make a positive contribution to environmental protection by making themselves aware of the company's environmental policy and complying with the control measures in place.
